



Renaissance Partnership Guide

Edmentum partners with Renaissance to provide Exact Path learning paths from the Renaissance Star Math, Reading, and Early Literacy assessments. This guide will explain how to integrate your Renaissance Star assessments data with Exact Path.

Renaissance Star Assessment	Exact Path Learning Path Subject
Renaissance Star Math assessment provides	a math learning path.
Renaissance Star Reading assessment provides	a reading learning path.
Renaissance Star Early Literacy assessment provides	a reading learning path.

Note: If students take the Star Early Literacy assessment ONLY, a reading learning path will be generated. If students take the Star Early Literacy assessment AND the Star Reading, their reading learning paths will be generated by the **Star Reading** score—not by the Star Early Literacy Score.

These are the steps you'll need to complete to integrate your accounts:

1. Enable sharing your Renaissance data with Exact Path.
2. Map your Renaissance account to your Exact Path account.
 - a. Use your Customer ID (obtained from Renaissance Customer Support if unknown) to map your Renaissance account to Exact Path.
 - b. Match students in your Renaissance account to students in Exact Path. Find which identifier you use for your students in Renaissance (SIS ID or State ID).
3. Set Test Windows.

Request Data Sharing

To request data sharing with Edmentum, you'll first need to [submit a support request](#) with Renaissance. Simply enter your contact information, your district name, Star Assessments as the Product, and Data Sharing as the Task or product area. Enter "Enable data sharing with Edmentum" in the description. Renaissance support will enable the data sharing feature in your Renaissance account **within five business days** of receiving your request.

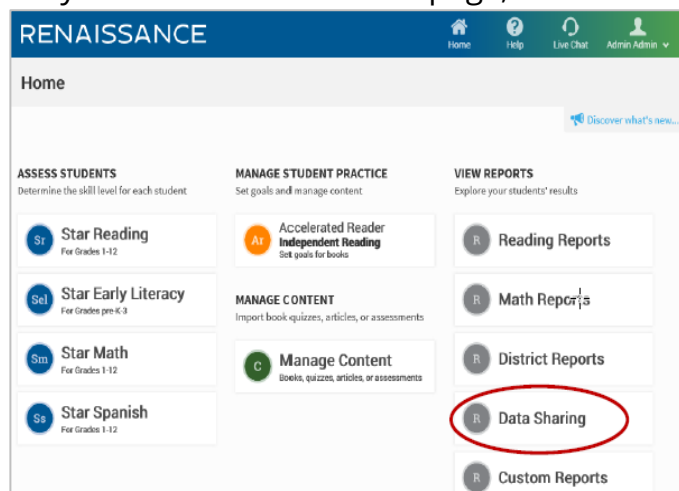


Enable Data Sharing

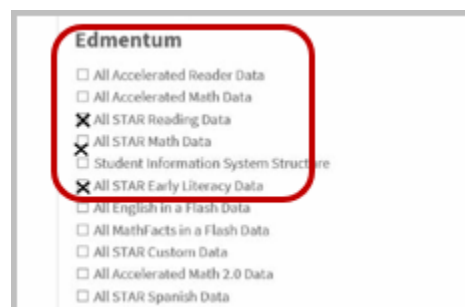
Once Renaissance processes your request to share data, the next step is to enable data sharing in your account.

Only the **district administrator** in Renaissance can complete this task.

1. On your Renaissance Home page, click the **Data Sharing** tile.



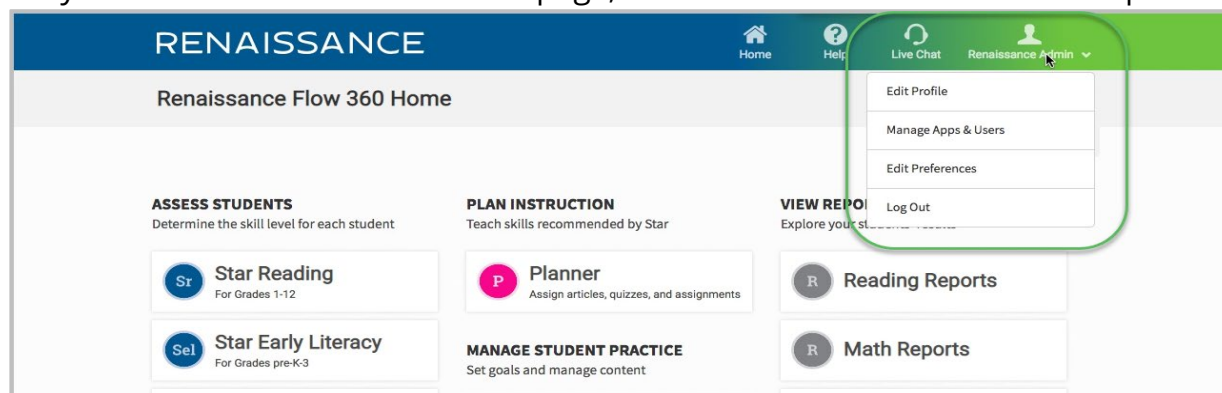
2. Read the security notice, and enter your name, title, and email, and click Enable.
3. On the Data Sharing Dashboard, select All STAR Reading Data, All STAR Math Data, and All STAR Early Literacy Data to share these assessments with Edmentum, and click **Save**.



Find Your District's State Number

You need this number to map your Renaissance data to your Edmentum account. Your State Number is provided by your state's education department. If you do not have a state number, contact your state education department to obtain one.

1. On your Renaissance Growth homepage, click the **Renaissance Admin** drop-down.





2. Click the **District & Schools** link.

3. Your **State Number** appears in the State Number field. Keep this number nearby. You will need to enter it in your Exact Path account to map your Renaissance data.

If you do not have a State Number, contact your state education department to obtain your State Number.

Important Troubleshooting Note: Ensure that the state number in Renaissance and the state number in Exact Path match exactly, otherwise your accounts may not sync properly. For example, 123-456 and 123456 are not an exact match and will cause a syncing issue. If your account is not syncing any Renaissance results, this is the first thing you should check. After making a change so that they match, syncing should start working within 24 hours. If you are still having issues, then please troubleshoot with Renaissance and Edmentum support.



Map Your Account

Be sure to have your State Number from Renaissance nearby. You'll need this number to map your Renaissance account to Exact Path.

1. Go to <https://login.edmentum.com/> and sign into your Exact Path account.
2. Click on **Settings** in the upper right corner.
3. On the **Star Account Mapping** page, enter your Renaissance State Number into the **Customer ID** field. This number is available in your Renaissance account under **Edit District** section.

4. Select the unique student identifier (SIS ID or State ID). This is the number that will match your students in Renaissance to your students in Exact Path.
5. Click **Map Account**.
6. Click **Next** in the dialog box. You will now be taken to the **Star Test Windows** page.

Note: If you unmap your account, it will no longer sync your Renaissance data. To enable syncing again, map your account using the same ID as previously used. If needed, you can map with a new ID.



Set Test Windows

A Test Window is the period of time during which your students' Renaissance testing data will be synced in Exact Path. You can have up to 5 testing windows during which data will be synced. This does not limit the amount of testing you do during the school year; it is just the number of times that data will be pulled into Exact Path to create and update learning paths.

1. Select the number of test windows. We recommend setting just your first Test Window at this time. This allows you to add Test Windows as needed throughout the year. There is no need to decide on all Test Windows for the whole academic year at this time.

2. Complete the date range for each Test Window.

You have successfully completed integrating your Renaissance data with Exact Path. Your students' learning paths will appear within 48 hours of completion of the Star Assessments.

Remember: Only reading and math learning paths will be generated. Language arts learning paths cannot be generated from any of the Star Assessments.
