Welcome to Exact Path!

We're excited that you're embarking on your Exact Path journey, and we hope you are too! This guide is here to help you find your way around the program.

Please remember: your teacher may have specific instructions that differ from what's in this guide. Always follow your teacher's guidance, and ask questions if you need clarification.

Logging In

1. Go to the Edmentum login page. <https://login.edmentum.com/>
2. Enter your Account Login, User Name, and Password, and select the **Log in to Edmentum** button.

Diagnostics

Exact Path works by creating a learning path of activities that are tailored just for you. It's the **diagnostic test** that helps to decide what should go into each of your learning paths.

The diagnostic test is not a typical pass-or-fail exam. Instead, the test determines what you already know about a subject and what you're ready to learn next. You don't get a grade for this test, and you're not expected to know all the answers to the questions.

If your teacher has scheduled a diagnostic test for you, it will automatically appear as a tile on your homepage.

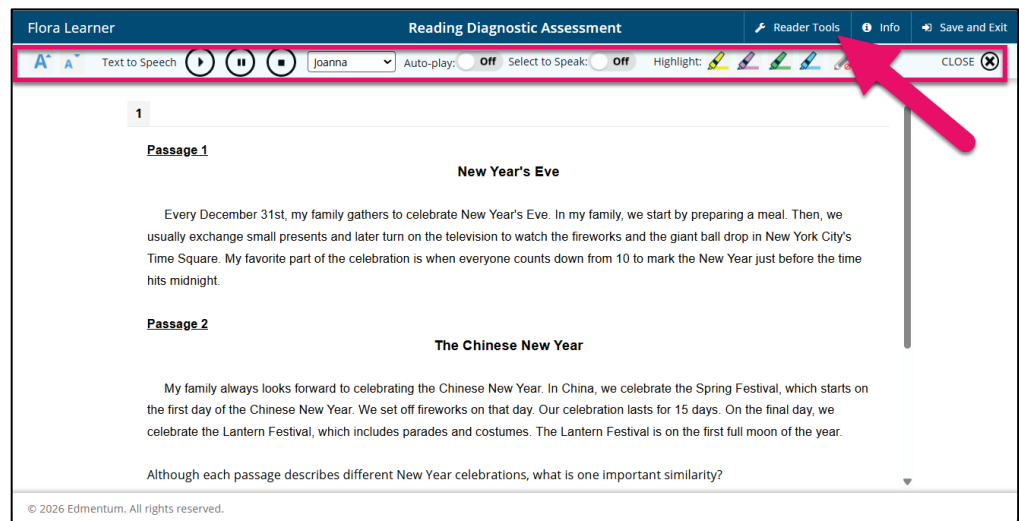
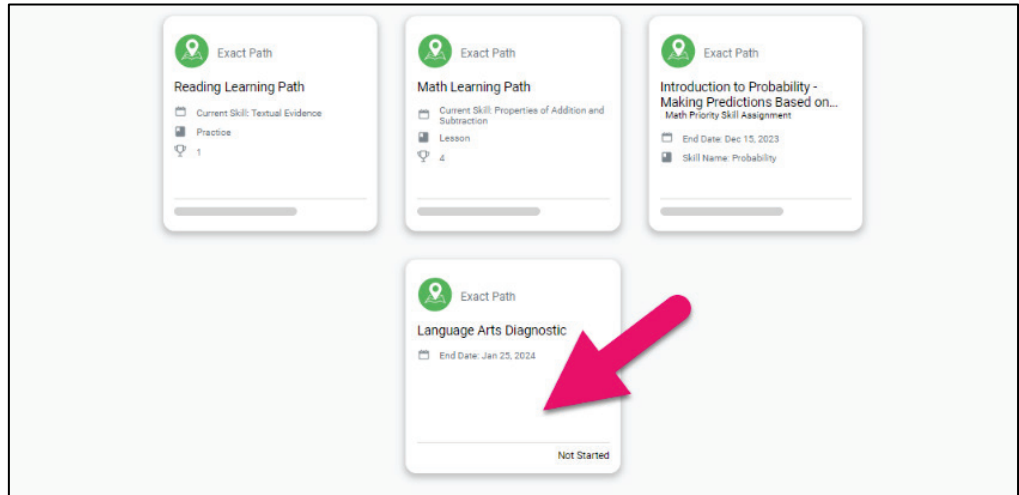
Select the **Diagnostic tile** for a subject to begin your test.

In the next prompt, answer the question *"Are you working in your school building?"* Then select the **Continue** button.

You must answer each question. If you are not sure what the answer is, make your best guess. Select the **Submit** button to move onto the next question.

The **Reader Tools** area includes a highlighter, a text resizer, and audio tools. If your teacher has enabled audio accommodations, you can use **Text to Speech** to hear the whole page read aloud, or use **Select to Speak** to click on any sentence and hear just that sentence. Once you have finished a test, the diagnostic tile will disappear, and a learning path tile will appear in its place.

Learning Paths

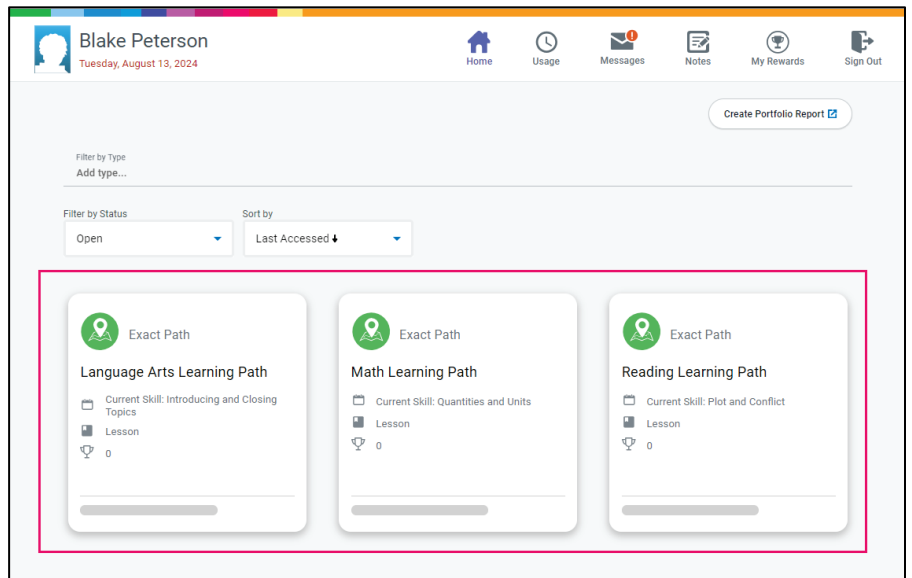
Learning paths in Exact Path are designed just for you. Within these learning paths, you will find activities to complete. You'll practice what you learn and improve your skills. You will have up to three learning paths, one for Language Arts, one for Reading, and one for Math.

Work on Your Learning Path

When you log in to your account, you'll be taken straight to your home page. This is where you'll find your learning paths.

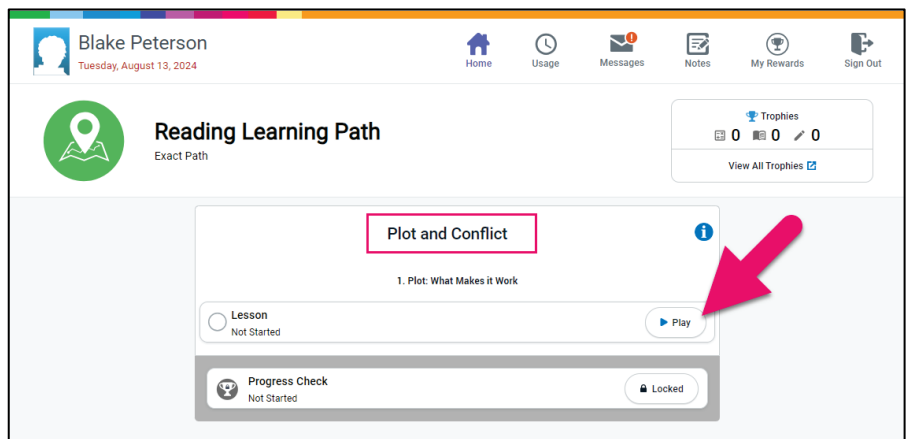
Select a **Learning Path tile** to begin working on your learning path.



This is an example of a skill on a **Reading** learning path. The section at the top tells you what skill you will be learning. Select the **i** button to learn more about the skill.

Select the **Play** button to begin the activity.

To **unlock the progress check**, complete all the activities that are available first.





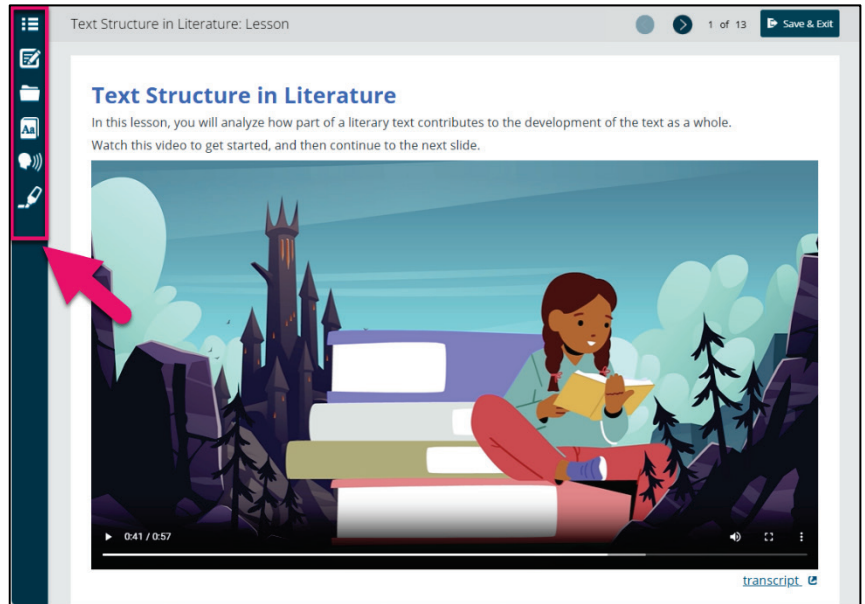
What Activities Look Like

Each activity will look a little different. Here are some examples.

Lessons

These teach you something new. Select the **Play** button to begin, then **read, watch** and **listen**. As you progress through the lesson, you'll answer some questions to check your understanding.

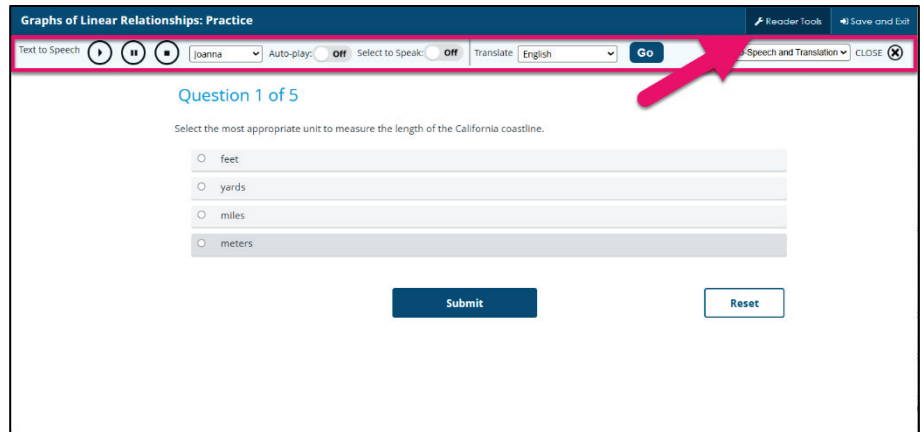
Use the menu on the left of the screen to access **helpful tools**. You'll find a highlighter, resources, a dictionary, reading tools, translators, and other useful things. They're designed to help you engage with your learning path in whichever way makes it the most understandable and memorable to you.



Practices

Practices ask questions to help build upon your knowledge and test your understanding. **Follow the instructions**, as the question types vary and require you to interact in different ways.

Select the **Reader Tools button** at the top of your screen to open a toolbar with audio options, a highlighter, and a dictionary. Use **Select to Speak** to click on any sentence and hear it read aloud.



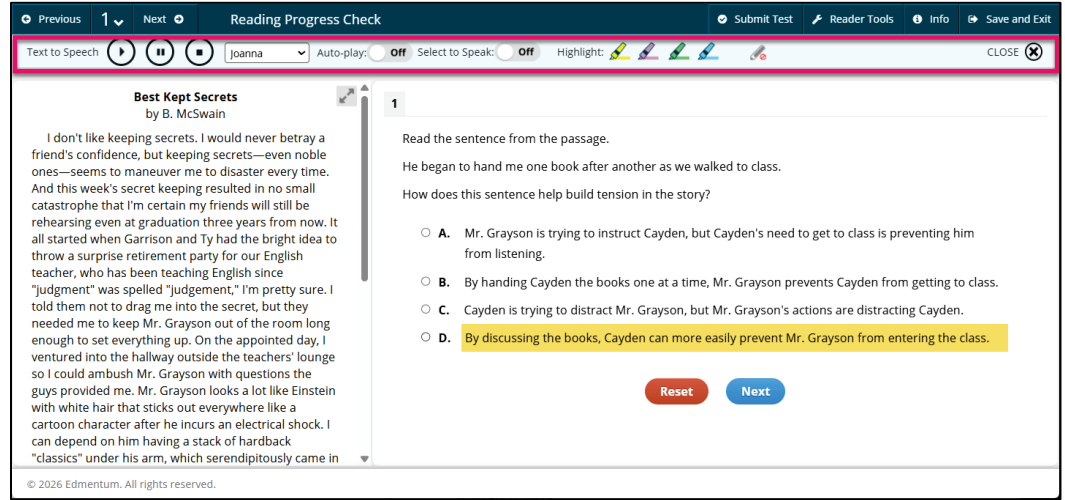


Progress Checks

Progress Checks are last. You are given questions about the skill you have been learning.

Select the **Next** button to submit your answer and see the next question.

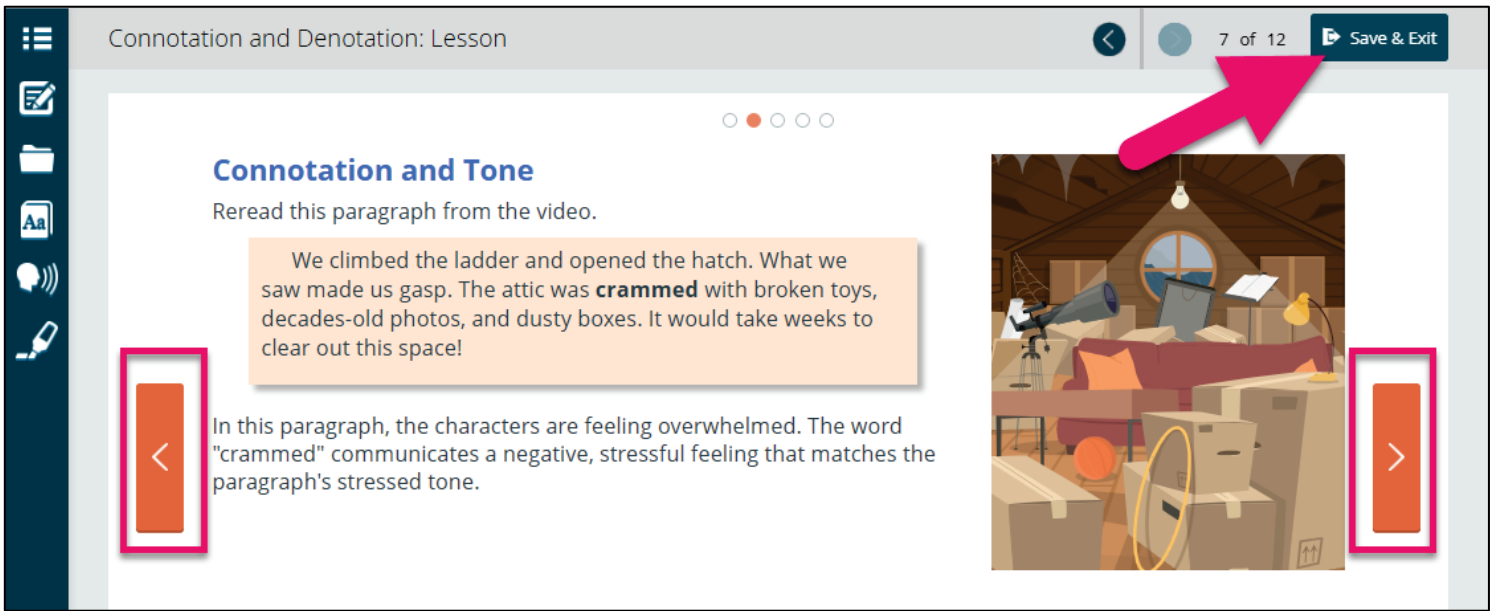
Reader tools are available in Progress Checks too, including **Select to Speak**. Click on any sentence to hear it read aloud. Score 80% or higher to earn a trophy! Then you can move on to the next skill in your learning path.



Navigating

Select **Save & Exit** to go back to your learning path whenever you need to. This will save all your work up to that point. That means you don't need to complete an activity in a single session.

Be sure to check if the slides have **multiple parts**. Use the orange arrows to navigate through all the parts of the content before you move to the next slide.



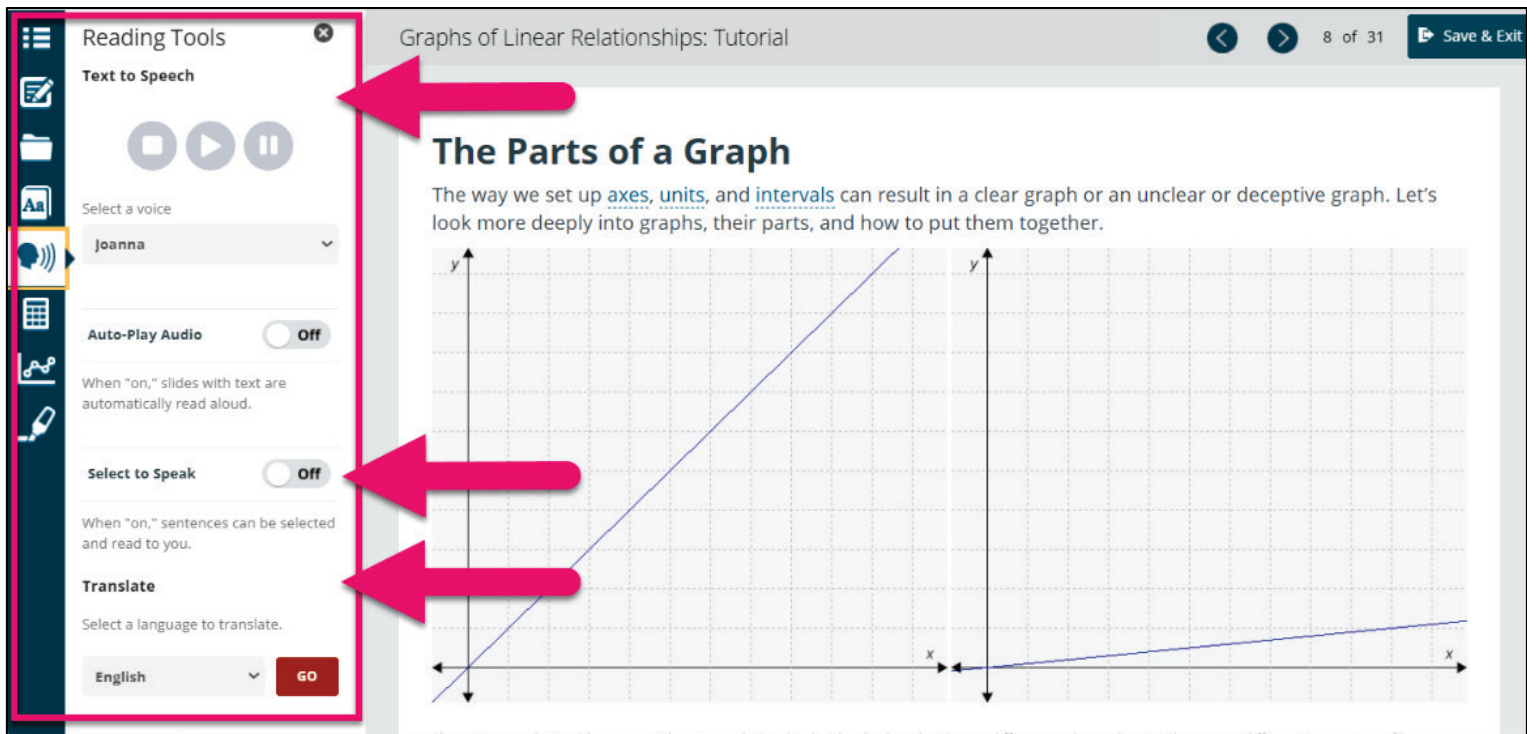


Text to Speech, Select to Speak, and Translation

Text to Speech

To hear a Lesson or Practice slide read aloud in English, select the **Reading Tools** symbol from the sidebar. Press the **play** button. The voice-over will begin, highlighting each word as it is said. It can be paused or stopped, and if there is more than one voice available, you can choose who you want to listen to from the drop-down menu.

If **Auto-Play Audio** is turned on, then the voice-over will automatically start with each new slide.



Select to Speak

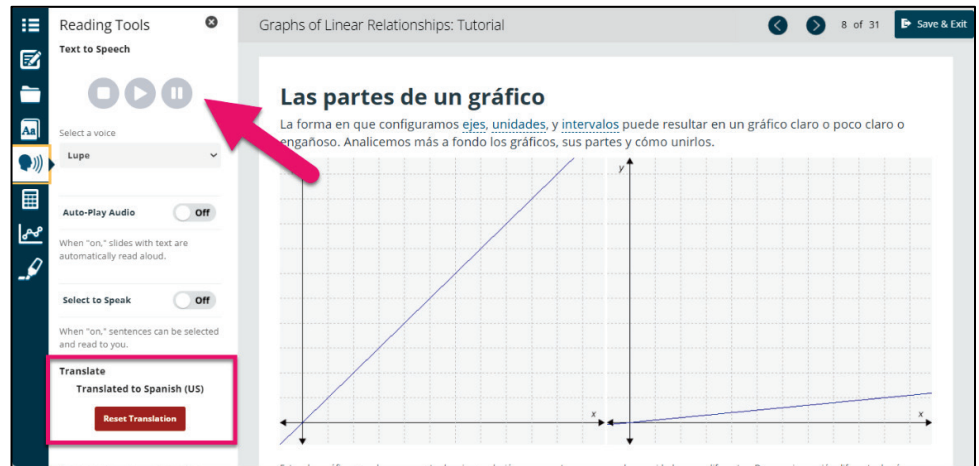
You can also use **Select to Speak** to hear just the sentence you want. Turn on Select to Speak from the **Reading Tools** symbol, then click on any sentence to hear it read aloud. When Select to Speak is on, the highlighter and some other tools are temporarily disabled. You cannot use Auto-Play Audio at the same time.

Translation

You can translate the text on your screen while working on your Lessons and Practices. To access the translation feature, select **Reading Tools** symbol from the sidebar. Select the **language** you want to translate into, then click **Go**.

Text to Speech with Translation

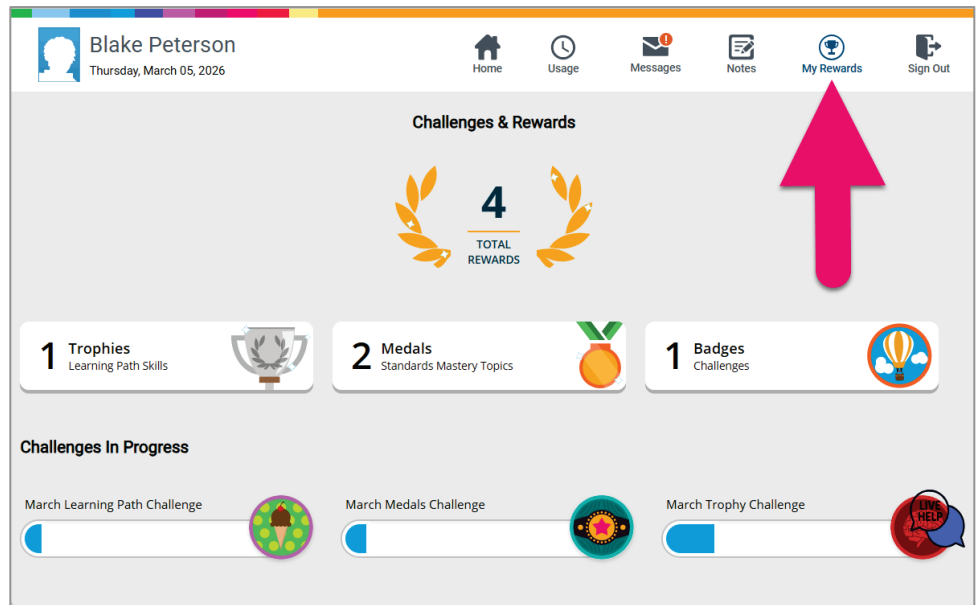
You can also hear the slide read aloud after translating it, **if text to speech is enabled for the language**. The controls will appear, and the voice-over will be in the translated language instead of English.



My Rewards and Challenges

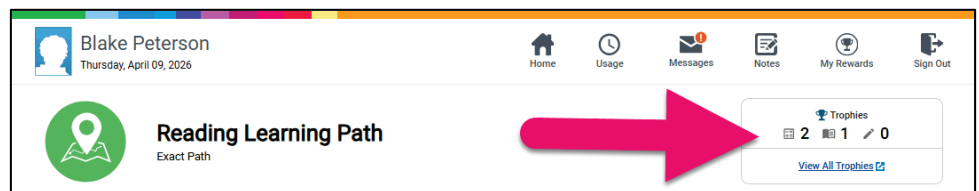
My Rewards

To see the rewards you have won, select the **My Rewards** button. On the My Rewards page, there are tiles for all the different types of rewards you can earn: **trophies**, **badges**, and sometimes **medals**.



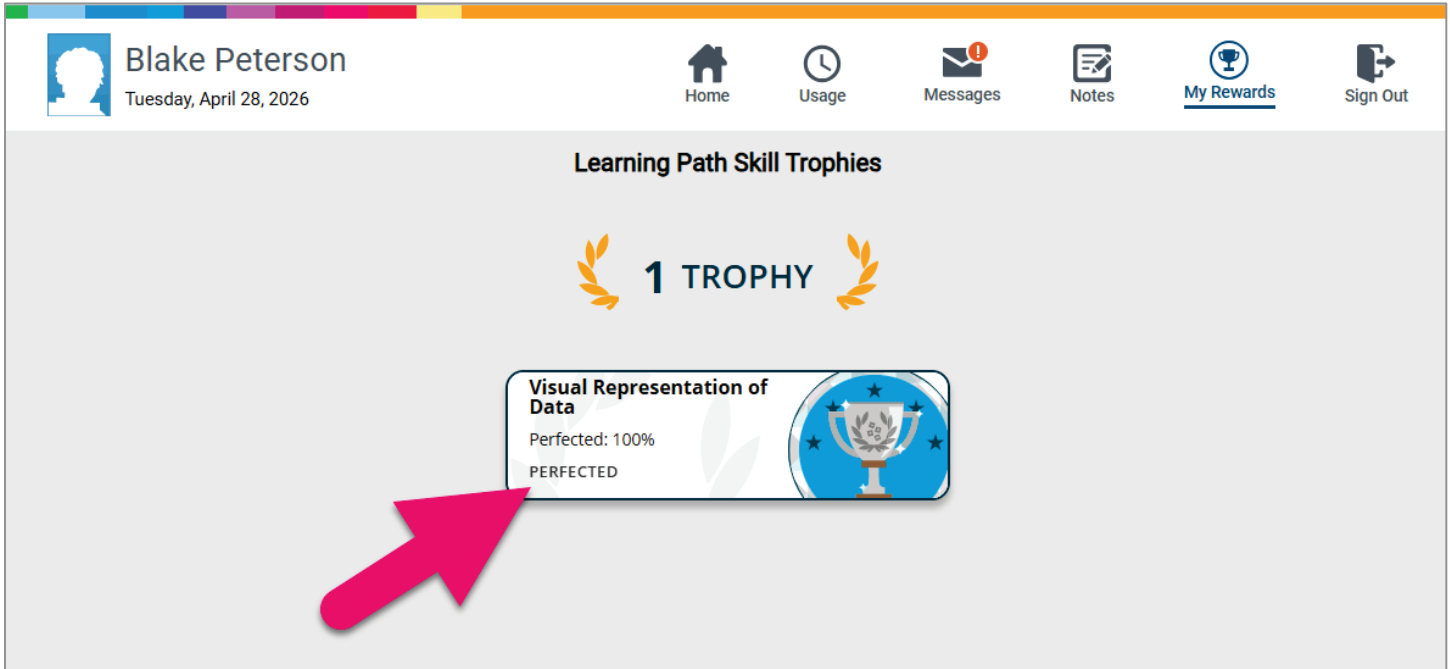
Trophies

You earn trophies by mastering skills. For a quick view of the number of trophies you have earned **during this school year**, select any of your **learning paths** and see a trophy count towards the top of the screen.





Find the trophies and badges you've earned for **all time** in the **My Rewards** area. Click the **Trophies** button to see all your trophies. Select any trophy to see information about what it represents: the subject, skill, domain, level of mastery, and date you earned it.

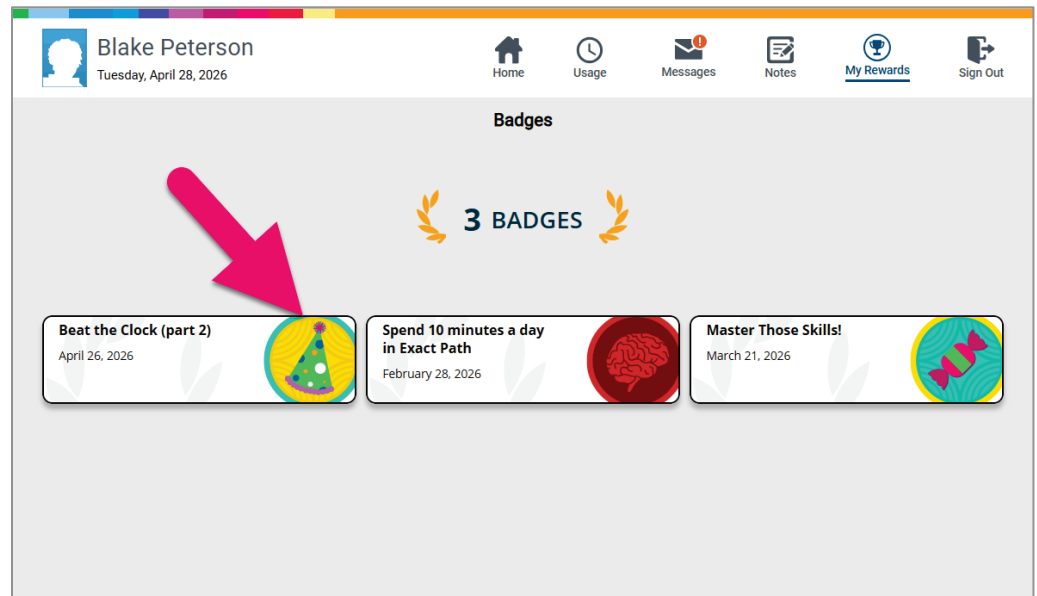


Badges

You earn badges by completing challenges set by your teacher.

To see all the badges you've earned for all time, go to your **My Rewards** page and select the **Badges** tile.

Just like with Trophies, you can click on any badge to find some information about what you did to earn it.





Challenges

You can check if you have any challenges by clicking **“See more”** on the banner on your homepage, or by looking at the bottom of your **My Rewards** page.

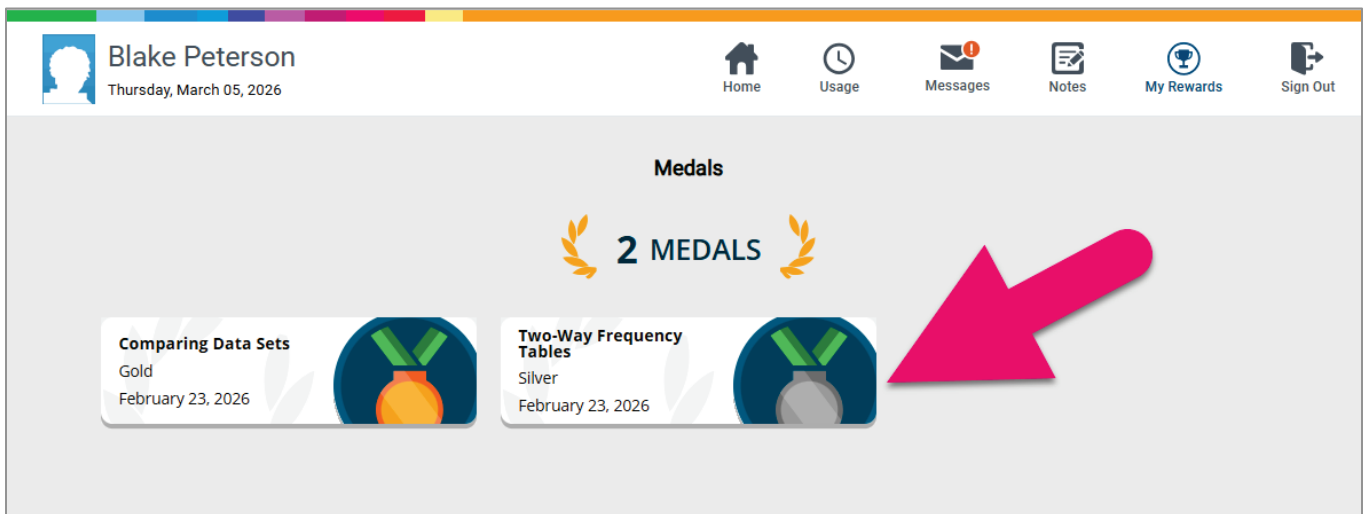
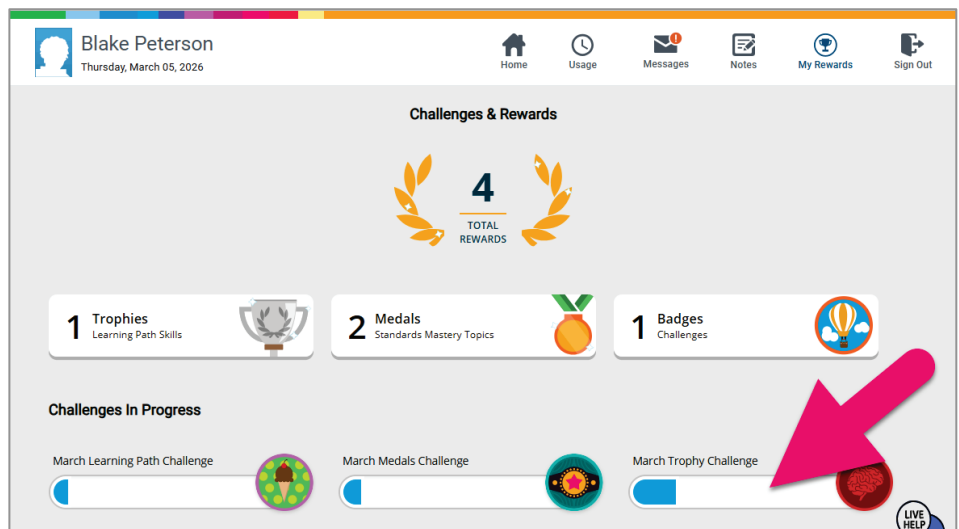
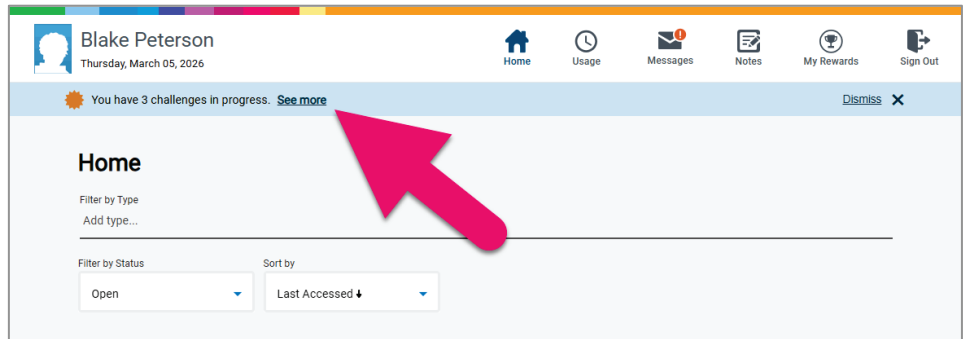
On the My Rewards page, you will see a **Challenges in Progress** section.

Each challenge has a progress tracker so you can see how close you are to finishing. Click on a challenge to find out what your teacher wants you to do.

Medals (if applicable)

If your school also uses Standards Mastery Assignments, you may see

medals in the My Rewards area. You earn medals by completing the assignments by answering at least 70% of the questions correctly. To see all the medals you've earned for all time, go to your **My**





Rewards page and select the **Medals** tile. Just like with Trophies and Badges, you can click on any medal to find some information about what you did to earn it.

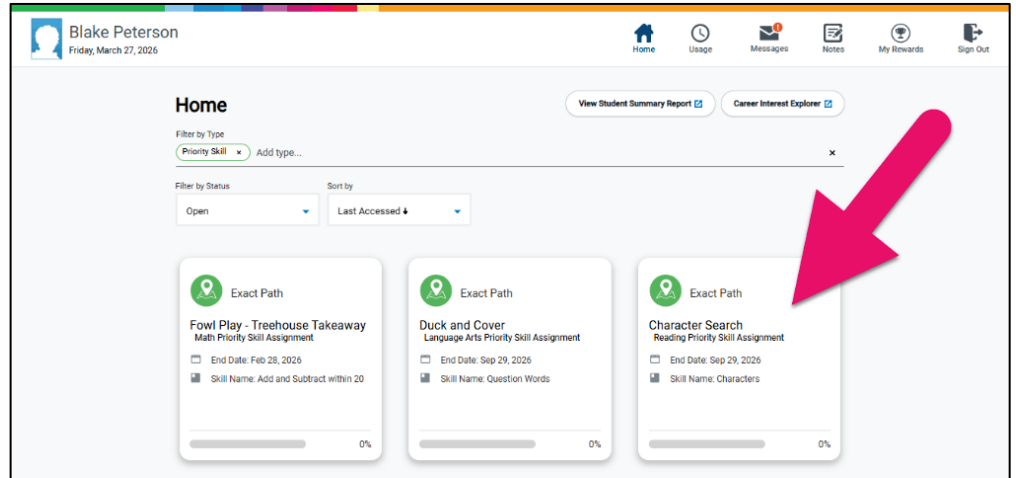
Assignments

Assignments are activities that your teacher might give you in addition to your learning path. They are designed to deepen your knowledge of particular skills.

If you have an assignment, it will appear as a tile on your **home page** alongside your learning path tiles.

Assignment tiles have a **title** so you know what they are about, and an **end date** so that you can see when you need to complete them.

Select an assignment tile to start working on it.

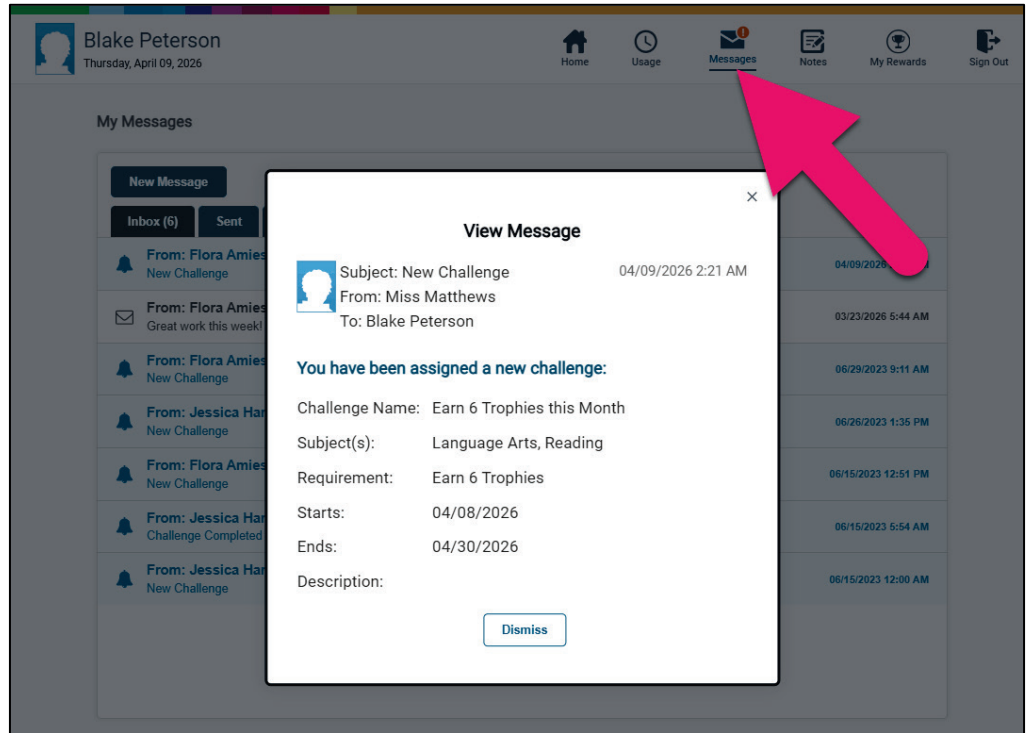




Messages

Select the **Messages** button to read notes or announcements from your teacher.

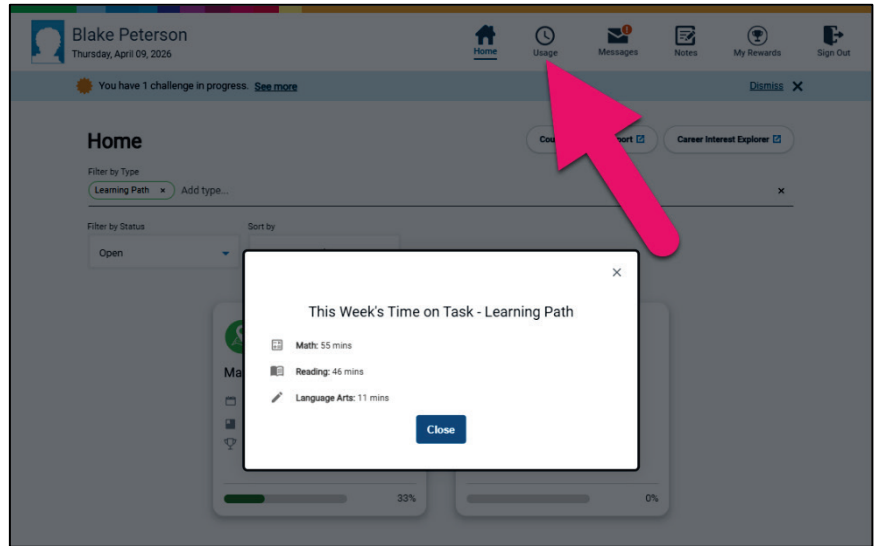
You can write a message to your teacher by selecting the **New Message** button.



Time on Task

To see how long you have been working on your learning paths this week, select the **Usage** icon from the menu.

The pop up tells you how much time you have spent in each of your subjects. It does not count how long you have spent completing diagnostic tests or Assignments.

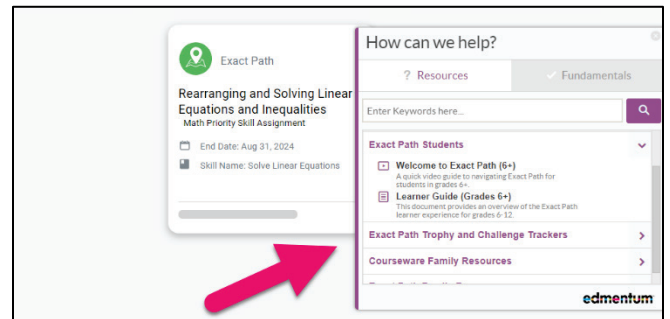
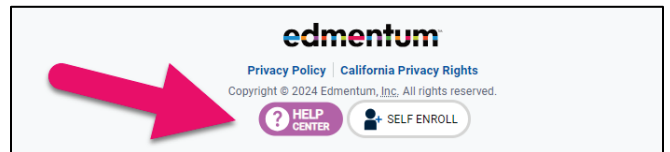


Need Help?
