How to Add Trusted Sites

The Trusted Sites list allows you to provide easier access to certain Web sites while maintaining higher security when using other sites. Note: We support the latest versions of Edge, Chrome, Firefox, and Safari.

If the Trusted Sites are not added to your browser you may experience some of the following issues:

- Blank white screen appears when trying to launch lessons
- Lessons stuck on "Loading" screen or "Access is denied"
- ERROR: "403: forbidden; access denied" when clicking Manage after accessing Class Learner Usage Summary in Classes
- ERROR: "The system has encountered a significant error" launching content
- ERROR: "Your browser is not supported"

A Note About IP Addresses/Ranges

Edmentum recommends allowing sites by domain and does not recommend configuring your network and workstations with IP addresses or ranges. In the event that Edmentum updates or expands our use of IP addresses, your configuration may stop working until updates to your appliances and workstations are complete.

Due to Akamai being one of the world's largest CDN providers, we are unable to ensure that the site will not be on shared hosts as other large name industries such as TikTok.

Blocking TikTok by domain rather than by IP will allow you to effectively prevent access to restricted domains on the IP such as TikTok while maintaining access to Edmentum content.

Steps for Adding Trusted Sites by Browser

Google Chrome

1. Click the 3 dots in the top right-hand corner, then click on Settings.
2. Click on "Privacy and Security", then "Site Settings".
3. Scroll down and expand "Additional Content Settings" then click on "Insecure Content"
4. Click the Add button next to "Allowed to show insecure content"

5. Enter the URL of your Trusted Site, then click Add. (Note: remember to use Chrome trusted site formatting, [*.]examplesite.com)

Mozilla Firefox

1. Click the menu icon in the upper right-hand corner of the browser, then click Options.
2. Click Privacy and Security.
3. Scroll down to the "Permissions" section, and click on Exceptions to the right of "Warn you when websites try to install add-ons."
4. Type the trusted sites into the "Address of website" field and click Allow.
5. Click Save Changes.

Safari

1. At the top of the screen, click Bookmarks.
2. Click "Add Bookmark..."
3. Click "Top Sites" from the dropdown menu.
4. Click Add.

Microsoft Edge

1. Search in the Start Menu for the Control Panel.
2. Click or double-click the Internet Options icon.
3. In the Internet Properties window, click the Security tab.
4. Select the Trusted sites entry and click the Sites button.
5. Enter the address for the trusted website in the Add this website to the zone text field.
6. Click the Add button, then click OK to save the website addition.

iOS devices

Adding Trusted Sites on an iPad or iPhone:

1. Go to Settings app on the iPad.
2. Select 'SCREEN TIME'.
3. Select 'Content & Privacy Restrictions'.
4. Make sure Content & Privacy Restrictions is toggled (in Green), then select Content Restrictions.
5. Select 'Web Content'.
