



# Recommended Reviewing for Diagnostics

The purpose of the Exact Path diagnostic is to ensure all students receive an accurate learning path that allows them to succeed. Exact Path alerts you when a student may not have provided effortful responses to test questions during the diagnostic. The alert triggers when a student’s average time per item is 5 seconds or less. We also give you the tools to take action immediately, including resetting the diagnostic, overriding the placement, or ignoring the warning.

**Note: The Student Summary Report is where you’ll go to review diagnostic results and reset diagnostics.**

## Recommended Reviewing Alert

If the system detects a diagnostic was completed too quickly, you’ll receive an alert on your home page, like the one below.

2. Click **Details**.

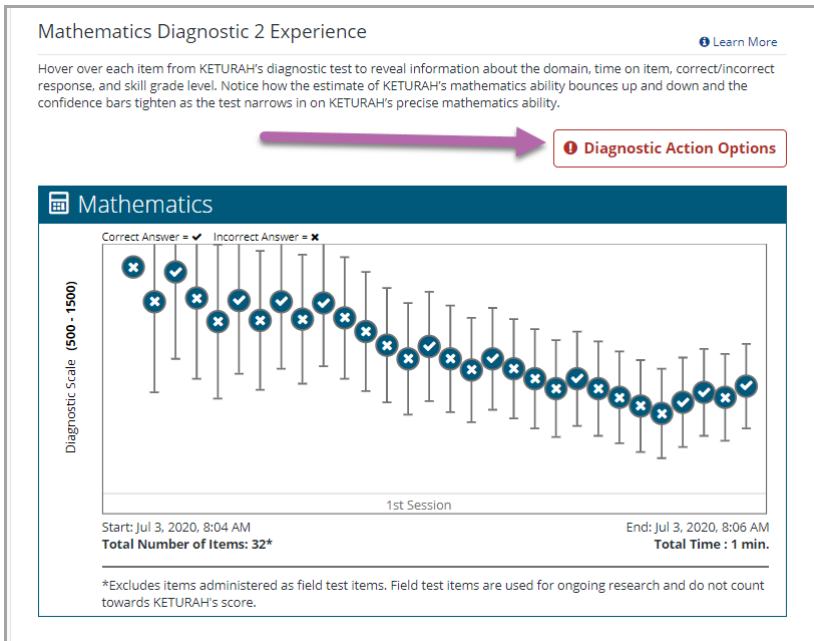
